Transitions for infants and toddler can occur throughout the school year based on a certain age or milestone that has been reached. Below, you will find a general timeline of when these transitions occur.

The Infant 1 program is for babies aged 6 weeks to about 8 months. Infants will transition to Infant 2 once they have reach 8 month and are pulling up and crawling.

The Infant 2 program is for babies between the ages of 8 months and 15 months. These students transition to Toddler 1 once they have reach 15 months and are walking steadily.

The Toddler 1 students are aged 15 months to about 20 or 21 months. Their transition to Toddler 2 depends on language development, age and class size in both Toddler 1 and Toddler 2.

Toddler 2 students are generally 20 months at the beginning of the school year (mid-August). They will not transition until the following school year.

Toddler 3 students are those that are at least 21 months at the beginning of the school year and will be turning 2 between September 2 and December 31. They remain in the Toddler 3 classroom until the following school year.
