Summer Welcome Page

Welcome to Summer Camp 2026! We are so happy you will be joining us and we look forward to having 10 weeks of fun and friendship!

A few things to keep in mind to make your summer a bit easier:

1. The Towne Creek website is your friend. www.thetownecreekschool.com
Once on the site you can click on the "**For Parents**" page to gain access to the school calendar, permission slips, What's Happenings and more.
2. The code to enter the "**For Parents**" page will be Summer26 starting May 29th.
3. You can find upcoming events on the home page of the website, and on Facebook.
4. To access permission slips on the website, enter the "**For Parents**" page. Scroll down to Permission Slips. Click on Download. Look for your child's age group. All permission slips for the summer should be located here.
5. You can also access the online calendar on the "**For Parents**" page. This will list all Field Trips, Camp Weeks, Swim Sessions, closures, etc., for the summer.
6. The new door code for the summer is: 2627#. This will be activated on June 1st.
7. PreK has Free Swim twice a week and Kinder through 6th has Free Swim daily (if weather allows). You can find the Free Swim schedule on the [Summer Camp Program - The Towne Creek School](#) page. Scroll to the bottom of the page to Important Links. Under Activities, click on the PreK and K-6th Free Swim Schedule. You can also find the weekly themes for each age group on this same page under Summer Weekly Themes.
8. If your child is taking swimming lessons and has Free Swim or Splash on the same day, it is best to send two swimsuits and two towels for ease of change.
9. Splash Days for Twos and Threes will be listed on the Summer Weekly Theme page. Teachers will also remind you via the sign outside their door. Be sure to check the door daily for announcements.
10. We recommend that you put sunscreen on your child in the morning before arriving at school. If you would like to have it reapplied, send a non-aerosol sunscreen with your child's name on it, in their backpack and let your child's teacher know that it is there and needs to be reapplied.

7. Wednesday August 12th – Towne Creek First Day of Preschool and Afterschool

Contacting Me

On the first page, I have given you my work email and my personal cell phone number. The best way to contact me is by either calling the school directly or by sending me a text message. I only check the email at 1 o'clock during the day on my break. However, if it is something you just need to let me know and it does not require a response, please text me. I have a smart watch, and I can read it quickly from there. I cannot use my cell phone in the classroom. If you need to verbally speak to me, please call the school.

Smart care App

Please check your smart care app at least twice a week. We will upload photos at least twice a week if not more. That's where you will be able to see all the neat things we will do this summer.

Drop Off & Pick Up

All students must be accompanied both in and out of the school by someone 18 years old and older. Please be sure you sign your child in and out each day by either using your key fob and the iPad on the table in the multipurpose room or have the SmartCare parent app.

Dress Code

Please be sure your child is dressed comfortably each day. For the safety of your child, we encourage you to send them in closed-toed shoes. Sandals, Flip Flops and water shoes should be worn on water days only. All students should have a full set of extra clothes available at school daily. (Including underwear, socks and shoes)

Take Home Folders

Outside the classroom door there is a table with a file folder on it. Each child has their own file and folder with their name on it. Please check these folders weekly. This is where you will find your child's artwork or any other papers I may send home.

Splash Days/Swim Lessons

For water activities, we ask that you provide a towel, hat (if you wish), swim shoes and sunscreen (non-aerosol). PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S INITIALS OR NAME. On the morning of Splash or Swim Lessons, please bring your child to school wearing their swimsuit under their clothes or cover up. Don't forget to have a full change of clothes available after the water activity, including dry shoes. If your child has both swim lessons and splash on the same day, it is a good idea to bring an extra swimsuit and towel for ease of changing. You should apply sunscreen at home. If you want us to reapply the sunscreen at school, please bring the labeled, non-aerosol sunscreen to school and let me know.


Heat Advisories

On days with heat advisories, we will either reduce outside time or eliminate it all together. Please continue to bring your child's labeled water bottle as we will continue using them throughout the summer.

Please don't forget to sign your splash day permission slips and turn them in!


