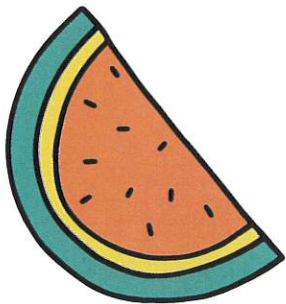

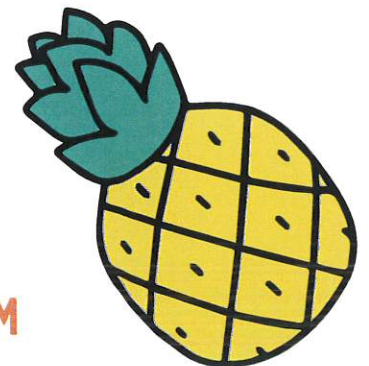
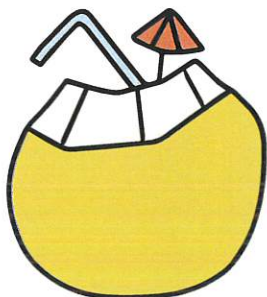

Summer Welcome Page

Welcome to Summer Camp 2026! We are so happy you will be joining us and we look forward to having 10 weeks of fun and friendship!

A few things to keep in mind to make your summer a bit easier:

1. The Towne Creek website is your friend. www.thetownecreekschool.com
Once on the site you can click on the **"For Parents"** page to gain access to the school calendar, permission slips, What's Happenings and more.
2. The code to enter the **"For Parents"** page will be Summer26 starting May 29th.
3. You can find upcoming events on the home page of the website, and on Facebook.
4. To access permission slips on the website, enter the **"For Parents"** page. Scroll down to Permission Slips. Click on Download. Look for your child's age group. All permission slips for the summer should be located here.
5. You can also access the online calendar on the **"For Parents"** page. This will list all Field Trips, Camp Weeks, Swim Sessions, closures, etc., for the summer.
6. The new door code for the summer is: 6126# This will be activated on June 1st.
7. PreK has Free Swim twice a week and Kinder through 6th has Free Swim daily (if weather allows). You can find the Free Swim schedule on the [Summer Camp Program - The Towne Creek School](#) page. Scroll to the bottom of the page to Important Links. Under Activities, click on the PreK and K-6th Free Swim Schedule. You can also find the weekly themes for each age group on this same page under Summer Weekly Themes.
8. If your child is taking swimming lessons and has Free Swim or Splash on the same day, it is best to send two swimsuits and two towels for ease of change.
9. Splash Days for Twos and Threes will be listed on the Summer Weekly Theme page. Teachers will also remind you via the sign outside their door. Be sure to check the door daily for announcements.
10. We recommend that you put sunscreen on your child in the morning before arriving at school. If you would like to have it reapplied, send a non-aerosol sunscreen with your child's name on it, in their backpack and let your child's teacher know that it is there and needs to be reapplied.
